Electronic Punching (SI) with waterproofed and overprinted maps

- Car Parking:** Linear parking on forest roads, signed from the historic Ashmore Pond (the highest pond in Dorset) ST 913178
- Map:** 1:10000 scale. Revised by Chris Branford Sept 2009
- Terrain:** A mixture of deciduous and coniferous woodland, mainly runnable, some steep valleys. The shorter courses use the less contoured eastern part of the woods which will be unfamiliar to most orienteers.
- Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown. String Course also provided. Courses suitable for beginners of all ages – help and advice available on the day.
- Registration:** 10.00am – 12.00pm. Competitor Registration Form available on the WIM website for optional download and completion prior to the event.
- Starts** 10.30am – 12.30pm with queuing start (Courses close at 2.30 pm)
- Entry Fee:** Senior £10 (£2 discount for British Orienteering members),
Junior £3 Family group (2 adult/2children £20),
- SI Card Hire:** Juniors Free: Seniors £1.00 (lost cards charged at £30.00)
- Facilities:** Toilets, First Aid,
- Dogs:** As this woodland is used for pheasant rearing the landowner has requested that dogs must be kept on a lead in the car park/assembly area and owners are requested to clean up after them.
